And the said negroes Hannah Thomas, Harriet and Mary I do declare to be free at the times here before mentioned from all claims of servitude or service to me my Executors or assigns to have forever. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this sixth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty.
