To all to whom it may concern Be it known that I George Barber & John T Barber of Anne Arundel County in the State of Maryland for divers good causes and considerations to them touching as also in further consideration of five dollars current money to us in hand paid, have released from Slavery liberated manumitted and set free, and by these presents do hereby release from Slavery liberate manumitted and set free our negro man named George Brown being of the age of Thirty five years and able to work and gain a sufficient livelihood and maintenance, and,

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
