Deed of Manumission and Release of Service

Whereas my slave John M. Davis has enlisted in the Service of the United States; now in Consideration thereof I William Bryan of Anne Arundel County State of Maryland do hereby in Consideration of said enlistment Manumit Set free and release the above named John a Davis from all Service due me; his freedom to Commence from the 23rd day of Feb^r 1864 the date of his enlistment as aforesaid in the 30th Regiment of Colored Troops in the Service of the United States, Witness my hand and Seal the 30th day of March 1864
