Deed of Manumission and Release of Service

Whereas, my slave from Adams has enlisted
in the service of the United States, now in consideration
thereof I Jonathan S. Warfield of Anne Arundel County
State of Maryland, do hereby in consideration of said
enlistment manumit and free and release the above
named from Adams from all service due me heretofore
to commence from the first day of March 1864 the date
of his enlistment as aforesaid in the Thirtieth Regiment
of Colored Troops in the service of the United States
