Deed of Manumission and Release of Service

Whereas we have Isaac Johnson has entered  
 into the service of the United States, now in consideration thereof  
 Jonathan S. Warfield of the County of Anne Arundel County State of  
 Maryland do hereby in consideration of said indentured  
 Manumission and Release of Service the above named Isaac Johnson  
 small service do hereby release and he commenced from the fourth  
 day of March 1844 the date of his enlistment or of his entry  
 into the 11th Regiment of Colored Troops, in the service of  
 the United States. Witness my hand and seal this thirtieth  
 day of April 1844
