That the said servant Eliza Ann was born in the year eighteen hundred and fifty to servitude for the term of thirty years in virtue of a deed of commission of John Blake Huntington deceased formerly of Anne Arundel County dated the 21st of March 1823 and recorded in Liber of Commission No. 1823 one of the Records Books in the office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court of the said County of Anne Arundel County. And that the said servant Eliza Ann is the daughter of one matilda woman named Caroline who was the daughter of the negro woman named ~~Caroline~~ ~~Caroline~~ ~~Caroline~~ the daughter of the Christian in the said deed named and now a free colored woman residing in the city of Annapolis in the said County commonly called Chivesy (and who is also the party grantee in this deed) who by purchase of the said Huntington personally representation became the servant of the late George Elwell Esq. for nearly eighteen years ended the 21st of March 1843 and whom the said deed then and there forth manumitted and in the language thereof "her increase both male and female and their increase forever when they severally attain the age of thirty years. In testimony whereof the said Elwell Esq. and the said Christian have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year first herebefore written
