

Senate bill entitled "An Act to repeal sections 112, 112 A and 112 B, of Article 2, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Anne Arundel County," sub-title "County Commissioners," as the same were enacted by chapter 342, Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, Session of 1892, and to re-enact said sections 112 and 112 A, with amendments, and to repeal and re enact with amendments, section 113, of Article 2, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Anne Arundel County," sub-title "County Commissioners," as the same was repealed and re-enacted with amendments, by chapter 515, of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, Session of 1896, said sections as amended, fixing the number and compensation of the County Commissioners for Anne Arundel county and providing the time when the terms of all the present County Commissioners of Anne Arundel county shall cease and determine."

Which was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Senate bill No. 5, entitled "An Act creating a sewerage commission for Baltimore city, and authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, to issue the stock of said corporation to an amount not exceeding \$12,000,000, for the purpose of providing, constructing and maintaining a sewerage system, to provide for the collection and disposal of the sewerage of said city, and the inhabitants thereof, and to authorize the submission of an ordinance for that purpose, to the legal voters of said city."
