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TUESDAY, January 24, 1837.

The Senate met. Present the same Senators as on yesterday. The proceedings of yesterday were read.

Joseph S. Cottman, Esquire, a Senator elect for the Eastern Shore, to supply the vacancy occasioned by the resignation of Thomas King Carroll, Esquire, appeared in the Senate Chamber, qualified by taking the oaths required by the constitution and the laws, and by declaring his belief in the Christian Religion, and took his seat.

The clerk of the house of delegates delivered a resolution authorising the joint committee on the library, to purchase certain books from London,

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on the library.
