On motion of Mr. Ricaud,

The following order was read and adopted:

Ordered, that Messrs. Ricaud and Schley, be appointed a committee to wait upon the House of Delegates and inform the Speaker and members thereof that His Excellency the Governor elect is now in the Senate Chamber, prepared to qualify, and that their attendance to witness the ceremony is respectfully requested. Messrs. Ricaud and Schley, left the Senate Chamber and after a time returned and reported, that they had discharged the duty assigned them.

Whereupon the Speaker and members of the House of Delegates appeared in the Senate Chamber.

The oaths of office were then administered to His Excellency Governor Veazey, by the President of the Senate, in the presence of the General Assembly, in conformity with the requirements of the constitution and the laws.

The Speaker and members of the House of Delegates retired.

His Excellency Governor Veazey also retired.

The Senate adjourned until to-morrow morning, 10 o'clock.

FRIDAY, January 6, 1837.

The Senate met. Present the same Senators as on yesterday. The proceedings of yesterday were read.
