We propose with your concurrence, to proceed to the election of Bank Directors on the part of the State, on the 10th day of February next.

Also the following bills:

A bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act to authorize William Krebs, Richard Linthicum and William Linthicum to build a bridge over Gwynn's Falls, at or near where the present bridge stands, known by the name of the Long Bridge,

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Brown, Tidball and Jones.

A bill entitled, an act to repeal so much of the act to limit and define the jurisdiction of Justices of the Peace, passed at December session 1834, as relates to Baltimore county,

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Brown, Jones and Hilleary.

A bill entitled, an act to authorize John Lammott, former collector in the third collection district in Baltimore county, to complete his collections,

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Brown, Jones and Hilleary.

And returned the bill which originated in the Senate, entitled, an act to make valid a certain deed therein mentioned, endorsed, "will pass with the proposed amendment."

Which amendment was read, and was as follows:

Add at the end of the bill "or purchasers from them or either of them."

Mr. Brown from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act to authorize William Krebs, Richard Linthicum and Wm. Linthicum, to build a bridge over Gwynn's Falls, at or near where the present bridge stands, known by the name of the long bridge, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second and by special order the third time and passed.

The Senate adjourned until to-morrow morning at ten o'clock
