Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on judicial proceedings.

And returned the bill, which originated in the Senate, entitled, an act for the relief of the heirs of Samuel Polk of Somerset county, endorsed, "will pass."

Mr. Ricaud from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act supplemental to the act entitled, an act for the relief of the heirs of Jane White, late of the city of Baltimore, reported favorably thereon.
