Mr. Alexander, submitted the following preamble and resolution,

Whereas, by an act of the General Assembly passed at December session 1834, chapter 241, entitled, an act to provide for the completion of the Chesapeake and Ohio canal to Cumberland, and for the completion of the Baltimore and Susquehanna Rail-road, to the Borough of York, in the State of Pennsylvania, the Treasurer for the Western Shore, is authorised to borrow on the credit of the State of Maryland, such sum of money, not exceeding two millions of dollars, as shall be necessary to complete the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal to Cumberland, and to pay the same over to the Chesapeake and Ohio canal company, to be applied to the purpose aforesaid;
