

Was taken up for consideration:

Mr. Brengle moved to lay the bill on the table,

Determined in the negative.

The said bill was then read the second time and placed in the hands of the chair.

Mr. Kerr moved to withdraw the bill from the hands of the chair for the purpose of amendment,

Resolved in the affirmative.

On motion of Mr. Kerr, said bill was then amended by striking out the second section thereof.

Mr. Brengle moved to lay the bill on the table,

Resolved in the affirmative.

The Clerk of the Senate returned the bill, entitled, an act to authorise Samuel Jordan, former Collector of Taxes, in the sixth collection district in Baltimore county, now Carroll county, to complete his collections, endorsed, "will pass," ordered be engrossed,

Also, the resolutions in favor of James Cockran, and Sarah Jenkins,

Also, the resolution authorising the joint committee on the Library, to procure from London certain books therein recommended, severally endorsed, "assented to," and severally ordered to be engrossed

And delivered a communication from the Adjutant General, endorsed, "referred to the consideration of the House of Delegates," and is as follows,

The Adjutant General of the Militia of Maryland, has the honor herewith to transmit, in obedience to a resolution passed at the present session, a report of the names of all the militia officers of the first, second and fourth Divisions of Maryland Militia, as they stood on the books prior to the first of November last, designating such as have not reported, as required by the 4th section of the act of 1834, ch. 257. Also, the names of such officers as have reported in obedience to the 4th section of the aforesaid act, and the vacancies that existed in the Division, Brigades, &c. on the 1st of November last. The appointments made by the Executive subsequent to that period, are also embodied in the report, and designated accordingly, with the exception of items made immediately preceding the meeting of the present Legislature.
