Which was read the first, and by special order the second time, and passed.

On motion of Mr. Hopewell,

The house took up for consideration the bill reported by him entitled, an act for the relief of Benjamin G. Coale, former sheriff of St. Mary's county;

The said bill was then read the second time, passed, and sent to the Senate.

The bill reported by Mr. Handy, entitled a supplement to an act entitled, an act to provide for the public printing of the State, passed at December session 1831, ch. 303, was taken up for consideration.

On motion of Mr. Culbreth,

Said bill was ordered to lie on the table.

The bill reported by Mr. Donoho, from the committee on Inspections, entitled, a further additional supplement to an act, entitled, an act for the inspection of Lumber within this State, was taken up for consideration;

On motion of Mr. Ballard, said bill was ordered to lie on the table.

The bill reported by Mr. Laveille, entitled, an act for the relief of Joseph Wood, former sheriff of Calvert county, was taken up for consideration, and read the second time;

Mr. Duke, moved to amend said bill by inserting in 1st section first line after "Joseph Wood, the names of James B. Dixon, John D. Ward and Henry L. Harrison."

Determined in the negative.

Mr. Parran, moved to amend said bill, by adding at end thereof the following proviso;

"Provided, that a copy of this act, shall be delivered by the said Wood, to the person or persons, from whom such fees have not been collected, and from whom it is designed to collect."

Determined in the negative.

The question then recurred and was put, shall the said bill pass?

Resolved in the affirmative.

On motion of Mr. Alexander, the house took up for consideration the bill reported by him as chairman of the committee on ways and means, entitled, an act relating to mortgages;
