Order to enquire as to the expediency of compelling the justices of the, in all cases where real estate may be sold by virtue of any process issued by said court, to place in the hands of the clerk of the county all papers and proceedings in relation to said sale, to be recorded, 100.

Enquiry as to requiring Sheriffs and Constables to make presentment upon oath at the monthly meetings, of the, of all and every breach of peace recognisable by said courts, that may come to their notice through information from others or to their own immediate notice, 143.

Leave for a further supplement to the act to establish, in the several counties of this State, 154; bill reported, 304; various proceedings on—bill amended, 645--6; passed, 646; sent to the senate, returned passed, 682.

Enquiry as to making the levying of a copy of a *capias ad respondendum* issued by a Justice of the Peace or by authority of the, at the dwelling or place of abode of an absconding defendant or defendants, who refuses to surrender himself to the proper officer, good service of said writ, 162.

Order to enquire as to requiring the plaintiff in an action or writ for recovery of a small debt before a Justice of the Peace or a, to pay his costs at or before the rendition of judgment, 162.

Enquiry as to the expediency of passing a supplement to the act. for establishing, &c. providing additional compensation to witnesses summoned to attend out of the districts in which they reside, 272.

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
