Mr. Eichelberger submitted the following amendment to the amendment:

Amend by striking out the whole of section third after the word "enacted" and insert the following: "That to every negro slave who shall enlist as aforesaid and who shall be manumitted by the owner thereof by a good and valid deed of manumission, to be filed with the recruiting or mustering officer, and by him duly recorded, there shall be paid at the time said negro slave shall be mustered into service the sum of twenty dollars, ten dollars per month for the next five months, and thirty dollars when said negro is honorably discharged from service;"
