Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Finance.

A bill entitled, "An Act to add new sections to article 84 of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled 'Schools,' giving assent to the provisions of the act of Congress donating lands to the several States and Territories for the benefit of agriculture and the mechanical arts;"

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Given, Willis and Firey.

A bill entitled, "An Act to make valid a deed from Henry Walker, guardian to Thomas Cox, of Dearborn county, in the State of Indiana, to Isaac Nicholas, of Somerset county, and to authorize the clerk of the Circuit Court of Somerset county to record the same;"
