Also, leave to report a bill relating to summoning jurors, drawing and challenge, in Allegany county.

Leave was granted Messrs. Ohr, Given and Firey to report a bill to alter and change the name of Daniel Mentzs, of Baltimore county, to the name of David Henry McComas.

Also, to report a bill to change the place of holding elections in the 3d district of Baltimore county.

Leave was granted the committee on Judicial Proceedings to report a bill to authorize the Judges of the Circuit courts to grant relief in certain cases.
