A bill entitled, “An Act to refund to Stephen R. Gore, late collector of taxes in Carroll county, a sum of money erroneously paid by him into the Treasury of the State ;”

A bill entitled, “An Act to refund to Julia Gittings, administratrix of Thomas E. Gittings, deceased, certain taxes erroneously paid ;”

A bill entitled, “An Act to enable the Mayor and Common Council of the city of Westminster, to enclose an alley in said city running parallel with Court street in said city, and sell or otherwise dispose of the same ;”

A bill entitled, “An Act to amend the 15th article of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to the power of the commissioner of the town of Rockville by repealing section 56 of said article and re-enacting the same with amendments ;”
