Also, a bill, entitled, "An Act to add a section to the fourth article of Public Local Laws, to legalize the various ordinances of the city of Baltimore to pay bounties to volunteers who may enlist under the call of the President of the United States;"

Also, a bill entitled, "An Act to legalize the action of the county commissioners of Carroll county in payment of bounties to volunteers;"

Reported them without amendment, and they were severally read the second time.

Mr. Ricaud, from the committee on Federal relations, to which was referred the resolutions for the appointment of a committee to extend to the Russian Naval Officers the privileges of the two Houses of the General Assembly.

Reported them without amendment, and they were read the second time.

Mr. Carroll, from the committee on Corporations, to which was referred the bill entitled, "An Act to incorporate the Maryland Soldiers' Relief Association;"

Reported it without amendment, and it was read the second time.

Also, reported without amendment the bill entitled, "An Act to incorporate the Liberty and New Windsor Turnpike road company of Frederick and Carroll counties;"

Which was read the second time.

Mr. Carroll, from the same committee, to which was referred the bill entitled, "An Act to incorporate the Dulaney Valley and Sweet Air Turnpike Company in Baltimore county;"

Reported it with the following amendments:

Amend section 8, by inserting after the word "paid" in line two, the following, "five dollars per share to the hereinbefore named commissioners at the time of subscribing the said stock and the residue;"

Add to section 9 the following, "and provided further that in all cases five dollars per share shall be paid by each subscriber at the time of said subscription;"
