

Also, reported without amendment the following bills:

A bill entitled, "An Act to repeal section 97 of article 81 of General Law, entitled, 'Revenue and Taxes,' and to enact a substitute therefor, so as to provide a more effectual mode of collecting taxes upon the stocks of incorporated institutions;"

A bill entitled, "An Act to repeal section 91 of article 81 of General Law, relating to assessed taxes on bonds of non-residents;"

Which were severally read the second time.

Mr. Eichelberger, from the committee on Judicial Proceedings, to which was referred the bill entitled, "An Act to amend the 15th article of Local Law, relating to the commissioners of the town of Rockville, by repealing section 66 of said article and re-enacting the same with amendments;"

Reported said bill "Ought not to pass;"

Report concurred in, and the bill was rejected.

Said bill was then returned to the House of Delegates.

Also, reported without amendment the following bills:

A bill entitled, "An Act to amend section 1 of article 18 of General Law, so as to require pre-payment of all fees for recording deeds, mortgages, bills of sale, releases, assignments or other papers required by law to be recorded in the land, chattel or mortgage records of the several counties and Baltimore city;"

Which was read the second time.

A bill entitled, "An Act to compensate E. W. Belt, State's Attorney for Prince George's county, for professional services rendered the State under an Act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at January session, 1860, chapter 326;"

Which was read the first time.

The Clerk of the House of Delegates delivered the following bills:

A bill entitled, "An Act appropriating a sum of money to pay the claims of James Revell, William J. Harper, A. M. Payne, E. M. Shipley, William R. Cole and George Jacobi;"

Read the first time, and referred to the committee on Finance.

A bill entitled, "An Act to add a new section to article 17 of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled, 'Queen Anne's county,' defining the jurisdiction of justices of the peace;"
