

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED:

In section 1st, line 13, strike out all after the word "alter," and insert "or renew."

In section 2d, after the word "dollars," insert "subject to provisions of the constitution, rules and regulations of the Grand Lodge of Ancient Free and Accepted Masons of Maryland."
