

A bill entitled, "An Act to amend section 106 of General Law relating to taxes on executors' and administrators' commissions;"

A bill relating to tax on commissions of trustees and receivers;

A bill to provide for the reduction of the amount of stocks of the State now held to the credit of the Sinking Fund;

A bill entitled, "An Act relating to revenues and taxes;"

A bill relating to collateral inheritances, distributive shares and legacies;

Reported them without amendment; and

They were read the second time. and made the Order of the Day for Monday, the 7th inst.

Also, reported a bill entitled, "An Act to refund to Wm. F. Murdoch, T. R. Rich and Leander Warren, Notaries Public for Baltimore city, a portion of the fees paid by them into the State Treasury;"

Which was read the first time and ordered to be printed.

Mr. Campbell, from the select committee, reported a bill entitled, "An Act granting the assent of the Legislature to a bequest in the last will and testament of Jacob Murdock, late of Carroll county, deceased, to the Lutheran trustees of Benjamin Church;"

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Carroll, from the committee on Corporations reported a bill entitled, "An Act to incorporate the Safe Deposit Company of Baltimore;"

Which were read the first time.

Mr. Given, from the select committee, reported a bill entitled, "An Act to amend an Act incorporating the Baltimore, Carroll and Frederick Railroad Company;"

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Corporations.

Mr. Firey, from the select committee, reported a bill entitled, "An Act to purchase and enclose a part of the battle field at Antietam for the purposes of a State and National Cemetery;"

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Stirling, from the select committee, to which was referred the bill entitled, "An Act to appropriate a sum of mo-
