A bill, entitled, “An Act to incorporate a company to make a turnpike road from Dulaney’s Valley to the Little falls of the Gunpowder ;”

Read the first time and referred to the committee on Corporations.

A bill entitled, “An Act to add a new article to the Code of Public General Laws, under the title of ‘Military Agencies ;’”

Read the first time and referred to committee on Finance

A bill entitled, “An Act to change the place of voting in Myers’ district, Carroll county ;”

Read the first time and referred to Messrs. Campbell, Bayless and Kemp.

A bill entitled, “An Act to repeal the act of January Session, 1862, chapter 107, amendatory to the 43d section of the 29th article of the Code of Public General Laws relating to the compensation of the crier of the Court of Appeals and the sheriff who may be appointed to attend said court ;”

Read the first time and referred to committee on Judicial Proceedings.

A bill entitled, “An Act appropriating a sum of money for the purpose of increasing the State Library ;”

Read the first time and referred to committee on the Library.

A bill entitled, “An Act to amend the 44th, 182d and 244th sections of the eleventh article of the Public Local Laws, relating to the compensation of the County Commissioners, Jurors and Judges of the Orphans’ Court for Frederick county ;”

Read the first time and referred to Messrs. Ohr, Eichelberger and Carroll.

A bill entitled, “An Act to authorize and empower the County Commissioners for Carroll county, in their discretion, to borrow money to pay to volunteers and drafted men, and to issue county certificates therefor, and to levy on the taxable property of Carroll county for their payment ;”

Read the first time and referred to Messrs. Campbell, Kemp and Ricaud.
