

MONDAY, March 7, 1864—7½ o'clock, P. M.

The Clerk of the House of Delegates delivered the following bills :

A bill entitled, "An Act making appropriations for the support of the Government for the year ending on the first day of January, 1865 ;"

Read the first time, and referred to the committee on Finance.

A bill entitled, "An Act providing for repairs of the State House ;"

Read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Rowles, Bayless and Lankford.

Also, returned the following bills :

An Act to incorporate the Union Club Building Association ;

An Act to continue in force the Queen Anne's and Kent County Railroad Company, chapter 149, session of 1856 ;

An Act to incorporate the Union Club of Baltimore ;

An Act to amend an act passed at December session, 1814, entitled, "An Act to incorporate a company to make a turnpike road from the square in the town of Boonsboro' in Washington county to Swearingin's Ferry on the Potomac river," to change the corporate name of said company and for other purposes ;

An Act to add a new section to the 84th article of the Code of Public General Laws of this State relating to schools ;

An Act to add the following additional sections to the 44th article of the Code of Public General Laws, title, "Maryland Hospital," prescribing an additional oath to be taken by the president, vice-president and visitors of said Hospital ;

An Act to repeal the act passed at the called session held at Frederick, April 1861, chapter 97, entitled, "An Act to amend the 75th article of the Code of Public General Laws, by adding a section to authorize the removal of equity causes in the Superior Court for Baltimore city, and in the Circuit Court for Baltimore, from one to other of said courts ;"

Severally endorsed "passed by yeas and nays."

Also, returned a bill entitled, "An Act to add an additional section to article 30 of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to crimes and punishments ;"
