A bill entitled, "An Act to authorize the Register of Wills for Kent county to record the indenture of Thomas H. Fountain of said county, on or before the first day of May next;"

Read the first time and referred to committee on Judicial Proceedings.

A bill entitled, "An Act to appropriate a sum of money to enable the Comptroller to pay such sum, if any may be found to be due, Frank H. Stockett;"

Read the first time, and referred to the committee on Finance.

A bill entitled, "An Act supplementary to an Act passed at December session, 1846, chapter 347, entitled, 'A supplement to an Act entitled, an Act for the relief of Passmore McCullough, of Anne Arundel county,' passed December session, 1843, chapter 188;"

Read the first time and referred to the committee on Finance.

A bill entitled, "An Act to authorize the payment of back funds to the academies of Anne Arundel county;"

Read the first time and referred to the committee on Finance.

A bill entitled, "An Act to amend article 94 of the Public General Laws entitled, 'Treasurer,' by repealing sections 8 and 9 of said article, and re-enacting said sections with amendments;"
