

Mr. Briscoe submitted the following amendment :

Strike out the sixth line, second section, of the printed bill all after the word, "Governor," down to the word, "then," in the ninth line, and insert, "that in case a legal number of votes cast at such election shall be equal in number to at least a majority of the votes of this State, as ascertained at the last Presidential election held in this State, and not otherwise, it shall be the duty of the Governor ;"
