Mr. Ricaud submitted the following amendment :

At the end of 9th section: "and this act shall be published under the order of the Governor in three of the newspapers in the city of Baltimore, one of them to be a paper printed in German, and one in each county where a newspaper is printed, once a week for three weeks before the day of election.

Which was read and adopted.

The bill was then read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

On motion of Mr. Ricaud,

Ordered, That this bill be made the special Order of the Day for to-morrow at eleven and a half o'clock, A. M., and that a final vote shall be taken on the bill at 3 o'clock, P. M.

On motion of Mr. Ohr,

The Senate proceeded to the consideration of executive business.
