TAKEN BEFORE
THE SPECIAL COMMITTEE
ON THE
BALTIMORE & OHIO RAILROAD,

APPOINTED ON THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

Mr. Seth offered the following order (House of Delegates, Jan. 23, 1860):

“Ordered, That a Special Committee of Five be appointed by the Speaker, to investigate the charges brought by Jas. E. Tyson, of Baltimore, against John W. Garrett, and the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad, in regard to the discrimination by that road, in the tariff of freight, against the citizens of Maryland; and that said Committee have power to send for persons and papers.”
