Also, a petition from George Walls, of Queen Anne's county, to have certain money erroneously paid by him into the Treasury of Maryland, refunded ;

Mr. Ecker presented a petition from Peter Baile and forty other citizens of New Windsor and vicinity, praying for an Act to incorporate the New Windsor Savings Institution;

Which was read and referred to the Carroll and Frederick county delegations.

Mr. Stockbridge presented a memorial from Rev. L. Van Bokkelen, asking an exchange of fifty Belgian muskets for the same number of Cadet muskets;

Which was read and referred to the committee on Militia.

Also, a remonstrance of the Baltimore and Harford Turnpike Company, against the passage of the bill now before this House, regulating the tolls on said turnpike;

Which was read and referred to the Baltimore and Harford county delegations.
