

passed at December session 1836, ch. 279, to lay off Worcester county into school districts, and for other purposes,

And the bill reported by Mr. Roberts, entitled, an act for the benefit of Henry Miller, of Queens Anne's county,

Were severally taken up for consideration, read the second time and severally passed,

The bill reported by Mr. Carpinter, chairman of the committee on corporations, entitled an act to incorporate the Baltimore Real Estate and Manufacturing Company,

Was taken up for consideration;

On motion of Mr. Hillen, said bill was amended by striking out, in the first section, seventeenth line, the word "five," and inserting in lieu thereof "two,"

On motion of Mr. Hillen, said bill was further amended by striking out in the second section, seventeenth line, the word "corporations," and inserting in lieu thereof the word "persons,"

On motion of Mr. Carpinter, said section was further amended by inserting in the seventh line after the words "holder or," the word "holders,"

The said bill was then read the second time as amended and passed.

Mr. Harrison submitted the following resolution:

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the joint committee to contract for the public printing, be instructed to cause to be published in at least four newspapers of this State, two of which shall be published in the city of Baltimore, a notice inviting proposals for the public printing of the next Legislature of this State, and that the said committee be further instructed to give the contract for said public printing to such person, or persons, as shall propose to execute the same correctly and neatly, and upon the most advantageous terms to the State, and that they report to this house by bill or otherwise.

Which was read the first and by a special order the second time;

Mr. Hopewell moved to lay said resolution on the table,

Determined in the negative;

The question was then put, will the house assent to the resolution,

Resolved in the affirmative;

On motion of Mr. Risteau,
