The house then resumed the consideration of the bill reported by Mr. Simmons, from the committee on inspections, entitled, a supplement to an act to establish State Warehouses in the city of Baltimore;

On motion of Mr. Hughes, said bill was amended by striking out in the first line, first section, the word "emoluments;"

On motion of Mr. Parran, said bill was further amended by adding at the end thereof, as an additional section, the following,—

And be it enacted, That the salary of the State Tobacco Inspectors shall be twelve hundred dollars, per annum, each.

On motion of Mr. Matthews, said bill was further amended by adding at the end thereof, as an additional section, the following—

Sec. 4. And be it further enacted, That the Inspectors of the several State Tobacco Warehouses aforesaid, shall keep a separate list, for each county, of the number of hogsheads of tobacco brought into and inspected by them in their respective warehouses, and report the same to the General Assembly of Maryland annually.

The said bill was then read the second time as amended, and passed.
