

rate of 6 per cent per annum, until the principal shall be returned as before provided; and if the said subscription shall be determined to be binding on this State, then that the payment to be made as aforesaid, shall be taken and accepted by said company, as a payment of \$250,000 on account of said subscription.

Resolved, That if the contract as aforesaid made, be held to be binding on this State, then that the sale and delivery of the State's stock as aforesaid, shall be deemed and taken to be a sale and delivery on account of the said Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Company, in part execution aforesaid, contract of bonds or certificates of State's stock, of the par value of \$250,000, and the delivery of bonds or certificates of stock of the par value of \$2,750,000, in addition to the said company, on their compliance with the terms and conditions of the aforesaid contract, shall be taken to be a full compliance and execution of said contract on the part of this State.

Which was read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.
