Also, presented a petition of Elizabeth Harvey, of the city of Baltimore, praying to be divorced from her husband Joseph Harvey;

Which were severally read and referred to the committee on divorces.

On motion of Mr. Geyer,

Ordered, that the treasurer be requested to report to this house the several sums of money paid as donations by the State for the purposes of education in Frederick county during the last year.

Mr. Adams obtained leave to bring in a bill, to alter and amend the criminal code of this State, so far as the same relates to free negroes in this State,

Ordered, that Messrs. Adams, Bowie, Goldsborough, Simmons, and Daawson report the same.

Mr. Neff obtained leave to bring in a bill, entitled, a supplement to an act, entitled, an act to provide for the electing commissioners for Allegany county, and prescribing their powers and duties, passed at December session 1829, chapter 25;

Ordered, that Messrs. Neff, Blocher and Sprigg report the same.

Mr. Eccleston obtained leave to bring in a bill, to alter and amend an act, entitled, an act to establish magistrates courts in the several counties of this State, and to prescribe their jurisdiction, so far as relates to Dorchester county.

Ordered, that Messrs. Eccleston, Tall, and Goldsborough report the same.
