Which was read and referred to Messrs. Powder, Shower and Berret.

Mr. Jump, of Caroline, presented a petition of Thomas Roe, and Louisa B. Roe, of Caroline County, praying the passage of an act to authorise and empower the said Louisa B. Roe, wife of the said Thomas Roe, to execute and make valid a certain deed therein mentioned;

Which was read and referred to Messrs. Jump, of Caroline, Carter and Turner, of Caroline.

Mr. Witmer presented a petition of sundry citizens of Washington county, praying to amend an act passed in 1798, chapter 105, wherein certain medical gentlemen therein named, are invested with certain exclusive privileges of practising medicine in this State,

Which was read and referred to the select committee already appointed on that subject.

The speaker laid before the house, a report from John Fisher, Inspector of Green Hides, in the city of Baltimore;

Which was read and referred to the committee on inspections.

Mr. Eccleston presented a report from the commissioners appointed at the last session to examine and ascertain what loss was sustained by Joseph Ennalls, in consequence of the act of 1835, chap. 233

On motion of Mr. Eccleston, referred to the committee on claims.
