of November Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and forty to answer unto Francis Allen,
gent. of a plea of trespass upon the Case &c. and the same day is given to the ap. Francis here &c.

At which day here came the ap. Francis Allen by William Arbuckle his attorney
and the sheriffs to wit John Standy gent. now here returned that he had taken the ap. Peter
Taylor whose body hereat this day he had ready to answer the ap. Francis Allen of the ap.
Plea as to him it was commanded.

Whereupon the ap. Peter Taylor puts in his place George Douglass gent. attorney
at Law against the ap. Francis Allen of the ap. Plea. . .

And thereupon at the request of the parties ap. day is to them now here given untill
next Court to be held at dividing Creek in and for the County ap. the third of March then next
following in the same state as at present saving to the parties ap. &c.

At which day here came again as well the ap. Francis Allen as the ap. Peter Taylor
by their attorneys ap. and hereupon the said Francis Allen complained against the ap.
Peter Taylor in the plea ap. in form following. . Somerset p. Peter Taylor ^{late} of
Somerset County Planter was attached to answer unto Francis Allen gentleman of a plea
