

Acts of Assembly Summoned
for the 12th of October 1640

Cacilius &c^o to our trusty and well Beloved W^m
Braithwaite our Commander of our Isle of Kent
Greeting whereas we have appointed to hold a General
Assembly at Saint Marys on monday being the twelfth
day of October next these are therefore to will and Require
you that without delay you assemble and summon all
the Freemen of that Island at a certain time and place
to be reasonably by you prefixed and there cause them
to make election of any one or more burgesses for that
Island (not exceeding the number of four) and to make
true return of the Party or Parties so nominated & elected
by the said freemen or the major part of them to our Se-
cretary before the said twelfth day of October Given at
St Marys the 14th August 1640

Cacilius Lord Proprietary &c^o to our trusty
and well Beloved Giles Brent Gent Treasurer of our
Province of Maryland and one of our Council Greeting
whereas we have appointed to hold a General Assembly
at St Marys on monday being the twelfth day of October
next we therefore much relying upon your Judgment
and advice in that Assembly do hereby will and require
you that you repair in person to the said Assembly at
the time and place prefixed there to advise and consult
with us touching the important affairs of our Province
