I would have you sett forth a portion of Town Land for Capt. Giles Brent Esq: containing to the quantity of Sixty Acres or thereabouts being warst together about the Smiths Forge lately built by the said Giles Brent and for so doing this shall be your Warrant Signed

Set forth for Mr. Giles Brent Esq: a portion of Town Land being warst together about the Smiths Forge lately built by the said Giles Brent wherof the North bound begining at a Market Tree on the Top of the Hill on the South side of a swamp called the Koy Swamp and running by a straight East line above the End of the Said Swamp is laid out for One hundred and five Poles the East side begining at the End of the said hundred and five Poles and running thro the Forrest by a straight South line is laid out for One hundred and ten Poles the South side begining at the End of the said hundred and ten Poles and running by a straight line West North West (or near that point) to the corner of a close now hedged in by the said Giles Brent and along that Hedge to the bank of St. Georges River is laid out for One hundred and ten Poles and the West side along the bank of St. Georges River to the aforesaid Market Tree is laid out for Eighty Poles or thereabouts so that the whole area therof containeth to the quantity of Sixty three Acres or thereabouts

Know ye that we for and in consideration that Giles Brent Esq: Treasurer and one of the Council of our Province hath adventured himself in person and at his own Charge in the Years of our Lord 1637 and 1638 hath transported into our said Province thence men servants to plant in our said Province have according to the Power of our Letters under our hand and seal dated at Warder Castle in the Realm of England 29th of August 1636 granted & lying warst together about the Housing lately built by the said Giles Brent Sett forth for Sixty and some odd Acres of English Measure both more or less bounding on the South with the Town land of his Sisters Margaret and Mary on the West with St. Georges River on the North by a line by a straight East line drawn from the top of the Hill on the Southern side the same called the Koy Swamp to above the End of the Swamp On the East with St. Marys Forrest and all Woods & Yeldings at our usual receipt fifteen pound in money Sterling or the Commoditye at Supra.

Mr. Ferdinand Putton demandeth Land due by Conditions of Plantation under these severall Titles following that is to say for men brought in by the severall persons whose Assignee the said Ferdinand Putton is and for men brought in in his own right.
