(173) Nations as shall be wanted to you by the said Simon or Henry
to have done unto them and other English injury in their Jurisdiction
otherwise, so the said Simon or Henry may bring the said
Indians before me to answer such Complaints as shall be
objected against them by the said Simon or Henry or any
others, And Certifie me what you have done herein as soon
as you may, And this shall be your warrant.

These are to will and require you to draw a
Commission for Mr. Giles Brent to be Commander of the Isles of
Kent and for William Luddington and for Mr. Richard Thomson
to be Joynted with him in Commission and to put the Great Seal
to it, and then send it to me to be Signed, and this shall be
your warrant.

Cecilus & I do all persons & Know Ye that We
do hereby appoint and authorise our trusty Counsellor
Giles Brent Esq to be Commander of our Isles of Kent in
all matters of warfare by Sea and Land necessary to the
resistance of the enemy or Suppression of mutinies and insurrections
to do all such things as to a Chief Commander do belong
and to be chief Judge in all matters civil and Criminal
happening within the said Island, And We do further
hereby authorise and appoint our trusty William Luddington
and Richard Thomson Gent to be Commissioners within the
said Island to all powers and as by the Law of the
Province do or shall belong to the Commissioners of a County
And We require all persons for the time being within the
said Island that they do acknowledge obey and respect the
said Mr. Giles Brent Mr. William Luddington and Mr. Rich^d
Thomson in the quality of Commander and Commissioners
respectively as aforesaid as they will answer the contrary hereof

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
