FHB Jun 17 1826/Died Mon 5th inst, at res of his father, in Frederick co, Captain George Murdoch, late of the U.S. army/Died 9th inst, Miss Fanny Ward, member of the Meth Episc Church, poor in worldly goods, rich in an inheritance from above Pol. Intel./Died Mon night last, David Mantz, son of Major Peter Mantz, of this city/Died Thurs night 8th inst, George Graff, young man, son of Sebastian Graff of this co
- $230.\ FHB$ Jun 24 $\,1826/\mathrm{Died}$ 12 May last, at his res in Mont co, James Norwood, in the 59th year of his age, husband and father
- 231. Filb Jul l 1826/Died Mon evening last, Capt. Samuel Cock, of this co /Died in Winchester on 16 Jun, in the 15th year of his age, after a severe illness of 5 days, Raleigh Colston Thomas, son of the late John Hanson Thomas, of Md Winchester Gazette
- 232. FHB Jul 8 1826/Died very suddenly in the harvest field, Thurs evening of last week, Elias Brunner of this vicinity. He was in a remote part of the field from the other hands, shocking grain, and at the hour for supper the family finding he had not returned home, went in search of him and found him lying beside one of the shocks dead. He was 70 yrs of age lacking a few months, healthy and active. He was born and brought up, if we mistake not, and continued to live all his days on the farm on which he died
- 234. FHB Jul 22 1826/Married Thurs morning last, in the Episc Church by Rev S. Helfenstein, Doct. Robert E. Dorsey to Miss Sarah Ann Duval, dau of Doct. G. Duval, all of this city/Died at Harrisburg, Pa, Mon morning 10th inst, Rev George Lochman, D.D. pastor of the Luth congregations in that neighborhood, in the 53d year of his age, more than 30 of which had been occupied in service of the church/Died at New York, evening of Mon 10th inst, patriot and jurist, Hon. Luther Martin, in the 82d year of his age
- 235. FHB Aug 5 1826/Died at his res near New-Market, Fri last, William Duvall, in the 77th year of his age Examiner/Died Sat last in Westminster, Ludwig Wampler, aged 74 yrs, 6 months and 15 days
- 236. FHB Aug 12 1826/Died Sat last, after a long and protracted illness, Edward Kehler, in the 19th year of his age/Died Sun last, William Springer, old inhabitant of this city/Died same Mrs. Rebecca Poole, consort of Valentine Poole, of this co/Died Mon last, John Hasselbach, Jr., in the 23d year of his age/Died Wed last, James Hilton, in the 35th year of his age/A fatal duel took place on 6 July last, near St. Francisville, in Louisiana, between George Brashier, son of Capt. Ely Brashier of this co, and Theodore Owens of that state. Failing with their encounters with pistols, they encountered each other with swords, when Mr. Brashier received from his antagonist 12 stabs in the neck and breast of which wounds he expired 8 hrs afterwards, in the 25th year of his age. Sprigg, consort of the late Otho Sprigg, of this co, leaving 6 orphan children/Died 15 Aug at her res in Morgan co, Alabama, Mrs. Martha Chunn, consort of Lancelow Chunn, Jr., formerly of Frederick Co, Md, in the 55th year of her age/From Ohio A young man named Thomas Statton, who said his parents lived in Frederick Co, Md, about 24 yrs of age, had one or two remarkable spots of grey hair on his head, went this morning to help John Jervis to raise a tobacco house and was killed by a log running over him. I believe his father lives near New-Market, Frederick Co, Md. Mathew Scott, Lion tavern, 28 miles west of Wheeling and 52 east of Zanes-ville
