## Governor Ready For Operation

Governor Harry W. Nice was prepared today to leave his office for five weeks in order to have his right eye removed at the Wilmer Clinic, in Baltimore.

The Governor said he expected to enter the hospital on Monday afternoon. He will remain there a week under observation before the operation is performed.

He expects to remain in the hospital for ten days or two weeks following the operation and will remain in his private quarters at Government House here for an additional two weeks to fully recover.
