Indian Post FUE For McKeldin Is Withdrawn

Maryland Gov. Theodore R. McKeldin's nomination to the federal Indian Claims Commission was withdrawn today by President Nixon in a blanket action which nullified 155 pending appointments made by Lyndon B. Johnson in the closing days of his administration.

An aide to Senator Mathias said late today that the junior senator had been assured by the White House that Mr. McKeldin's name had been withdrawn "without prejudice" and that here was still "a real possibility that it would be resubmitted
