In the affair between Doctor Claude & Capt Scott
the morning of the 14th inst after exchanging a few, it
agreed by the seconds Capt Peter's Bankhead, that Capt Scott
should acknowledge that the weapon he made use of to hurt
Claude was work and drawn forth by a letter of the
Doctor which tended to humiliate him, and that he
entertained no unfriendly sentiments towards the Doctor.
The Doctor assured Capt Scott that he meant nothing
personal at the commencement and that he was
disposed to be on friendly terms, the affair here
terminated.
