DEATH OF GEN. WM. LINGAN GAITHER. A telegraphic despatch from Berkeley Springs announces the death at that place, on Monday morning last, of Gen. WILLIAM LINGAN GAITHER, of Montgomery county, Maryland. Gen. Garters was well known as a prominent politician. He represented his county for several vers in the House of Delevates and also in the

State Seaste, of which body he was a member at the time of his lamented death. The deceased was dutinguished for his high-toned gentlemently qualities and eminent talents. Somewhat over a year 290 Gen. OATPERS was attacked severely with typhoid fever, and heaver fully recovered from its effects. He had gone to Berkeley Springs in the hope of recuperating, but his constitution

was too much impaired.
