In our Circuit Court on Wednesday last Mr Frank N. Holmes, attorney, moved for the admission of Richard E. King, colored, of Charles County to the St. Mary's Bar. The committee, Messrs. D. R. Magruder,

R. C. Combs and E. B. Abell, appointed to examine him, reported on Thursday that they had performed the duties assigned them and that whilst Mr. King displayed minute accuracy in answering many legal definitions, he seemed deficient in the comprehension of the general principles of law; and recommended farther reading and a more thorough study of our statutory law.
