At the request of Caleb Bentley the following Mortgage was recorded the 7th day of October 1819. Court: Know all men by these presents that I Joseph E Bentley of Montgomery County and State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars current money to me in hand paid by Caleb Bentley of the County and State aforesaid at or before the making and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof I the said Joseph E Bentley do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Caleb Bentley his executors Administrators and assigns, three feather beds, three bolsters, ten pillows, ten pillow cases, three pair bedsteads, fifteen Blankets, sixteen Shirts, six Shirts, nine towels, seven table cloths, one mahogany table two Mahogany Bureaus, one portable writing Desk, one Secretary, one ten plate stove, one tea kettle, three Iron pots, two Dutch ovens, two pair And Irons, two pair shovels & tongs, three Sad Irons, eighteen Chairs, one cradle, six trunks, three tubs, one looking glass one pair plated Candelsticks, one pair brass ditto, three tin ditto, four waiter four sets knives & forks, one dozen Silver table spoons, eleven silver tea spoons, one silver ladle, one Carpet, one saddle, one large bible one small ditto, Spectator, practical education Harveys education, Coropius Poems, Placidan Lost, Brookes Gazetteer, Life of Cook, Smith Lectures Dryden's Astronomy, Federalist, Curran's Speeches, Ramsays Poems, Thompsons Seasons, Johnsons Idylls, Davis's Domestic Medicine, bed and window curtains, China, glass & Queens ware, now in my possession. To have and to hold the said goods and furniture to the said Caleb Bentley his executors Administrators and assigns for ever; And I the said Joseph E Bentley for myself my heirs executors and administrators the aforesaid goods and furniture to the said Caleb Bentley his executors Administrators and assigns, against me the said Joseph E Bentley my executors Administrators and assigns and against all and every person and persons whomsoever shall and will warrant and for ever defend by these presents. provided nevertheless that in case I the said Joseph E Bentley shall pay and satisfy to the said Caleb Bentley or to his executors Administrators or assigns the sum of three hundred dollars current money with interest for the same on or before the first day of June next ensuing then this bill of sale and every matter and thing therein expressed shall be void and of none effect it being the true intent and meaning thereof, that the said goods and furniture is mortgaged by me the said Joseph E Bentley to secure to the said Caleb Bentley the payment of the money aforesaid.
