of my worldly affairs in case of my decease, do hereby make and
publish this my last Will and Testament.

Item I commit my Soul to God, seeking and asking for
pardon of sins, thro' the mediation and atonement of our be-
loved Saviour & Lord Jesus Christ and in the hope of receiving
the same commit my body, to the Earth to be there decently and
plainly interred.

Item, I give bequeath and devise all my estate real, person-
al and mixed debts rights and credits absolutely to my dear
Wife Ann E Gill to have and to hold to her her heirs Execu-
tors & administrators.

My estate being small and not more than adequate to the
support of my dear wife and children, I commit to her mater-
nal care and tenderness, all the means I have of providing for
and educating our dear infants, well knowing that no parent can
be more solicitous for their welfare than she will be in my
absence. And I do hereby further will that in case any of
the specific property which my wife may take as my devisee
should remain in her at her decease & her property, it shall
go to my children & their heirs &c, share & share alike. And if
none of my children shall be then alive, then to my dear
Mother and her heirs.

In witness whereof, I have made, declared and published this as my last Will and Testament at Annapolis this eighth day of October 1830, hereby revoking all other Wills and confirming this as my last
