to be jacent to my hand.

This Agreement, made the eighth day of April in the year of our Lord One thousand
eight hundred and four between James Lloyd of Kent County and State of Maryland of the
one part and Richard Tristly of the same County and State of the other part witnesseth that the
said James Lloyd for and in consideration of the sum of five shillings current money of Eng-
land to him in hand paid by the said Richard Tristly and also the sum of ten thousand
five hundred and forty eight dollars to him in hand paid by a certain Henry Waller there-
-cept of which respective sums of money he the said James Lloyd doth hereby acknowledge
and for every part and parcel thereof doth hereby accept receive and discharge the said
Richard Tristly and Henry Waller their heirs Executors and Administrators her the said
James Lloyd hath granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed and assigned and by these pres-
ents doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said Richard Tristly his
Heirs and Assigns all that tract or parcel of land contained lying and being within the line
marks and boundaries herein after mentioned and especially consisting of parts of the lands cal-
led Country Hall and Old Towne situate lying and being on the east side of the
Chesapeake Bay in Kent County beginning on the beach of a Pond called Herring Pond at the
said Pond north midway betwix the two Points of fast land and running thence up the
middle of said Pond to the Head thereof then up the valley to a bounded Pond which by Ad-
dition chosen and appointed by Matthias and William Harris was set up as a boundary
between the lands of the said Matthias and William Harris and from the said Pond run-
ning last eleven Paces then south twenty four Paces east thirty five Paces then East forty
two Paces and one half of a Pace then South nine degrees thirty minutes West seventy eight
Paces then South fifty seven degrees East ten Paces till it intersects the line of the land
called Plantation then West with the line of Plantation to the Bay side then by and with the
Bay to the original place of beginning containing within the boundaries aforesaid two hundred
and fifty three acres of land more or less together with all and singular the buildings and im-
provements wodds ways water water courses rights of water privileges hereditaments and ap-
pertinances whatsoever therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining and the reversion
and reversions remainder and remainders unto ipsius and his heirs thereof and all the
estate right title and interest whatsoever of him the said James Lloyd both at law and
in equity for to and out of the said tract or parcels of land and Premises hereby
bargained and sold or meant mentioned or intended hereby so to be and every and any part
or parcel thereof to have and to hold the abovementioned tract or parcels of land called
Country Hall & Hilles Towne or by whatever name or the same may be called together
with the buildings improvements and other appurtenances and all and singular other
the Premises hereby bargained and sold or meant mentioned or intended hereby
to be and every part and parcel thereof with them and every of their appurtenances unto
the said Richard Tristly his Heirs and Assigns forever and to and for us otherwise created
whatsoever in this instrument and it is the true intention of the parties to this Indenture
and Omenments aforesaid for the several uses and trusts following that is in trust and
for the use of Mrs. Milinda Waller and her children begotten by her husband Henry
Waller until the said Henry Waller shall become a naturalized citizen of the United States
