That Indenture, made this fifth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and seven between William Clayton of Kent County in the State of Mary-
land Farmer of the one part and Thomas Luby of Kent County in the State aforesaid
Farmer of the other part witnesseth that he the said William Clayton for and in consid-
eration of the sum of thirty seven pounds ten shillings current money to him in hand
paid by the said Thomas Luby the receipt whereof he the said William doth hereby acknowl-
edge and himself therewith fully satisfied contented and paid have granted bargained
sold aliened conveyed conveyed and confirmed and doth by these presents grant bargain
sell alien convey and confirm unto him the said Thomas Luby his heirs and
assigns forever all that twenty acres of land lying and being in Kent County aforesaid
being parts of two tracts or parcels of land commonly called and known by the names
of Mill Pond and Pines Meadow adjoining of lands of David Clayton upon the
North and lands of the heirs of Robert Adams upon the South bordering upon the main
road leading between the said William Clayton and James Clayton running to
the Delaware line as lately laid down by commissioners recently appointed by an act
of the General Assembly of this State with all and singular the improvements thereto

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
