Be it Remembered that on the fifteenth Day of July Eighteen hundred and twenty two a Deed of Mortgage was brought to be enrolled among the Land Records of Kent County the tenor whereof here ensues in the following words to wit: This Indenture made this second day of July in the Year of Our Lord One thousand Eight Hundred and twenty two, between William Stansbury of the City of Baltimore in Baltimore County and State of Maryland Merchant of the One part, and the President Directors and Company of the City Bank of Baltimore, of the Other part. Whereas for the purpose of securing and indemnifying the said William Stansbury against all loss and damage, consequent upon his lending to Richard Frisby of Baltimore County aforesaid his the said Stansbury's Promissory Note for Three Thousand Dollars, which had been negotiated and discounted at the City Bank of Baltimore aforesaid for his the said Richard Frisby's use and accommodation, - he the said Richard Frisby by Indenture bearing date on or about the ninth day of March One thousand eight hundred and twenty for the Considerations therein expressed, did grant and convey by way of Mortgage unto the said William Stansbury his heirs and assigns forever a certain part of a Tract of wood Lands known by the name of the Swamp situate any lying in Kent County and State aforesaid containing seventy eight Acres or thereabout: As by reference to the said Indenture recorded among the Land Records of Kent County aforesaid may more fully and at large appear. And whereas by Indenture bearing date on or about the twenty ninth day of June last past made between the said Richard Frisby of the first part, John W. Wilmer Edwards Palmer and James Carroll all of the City of Baltimore aforesaid of the second part, and the President Directors and Company of the City Bank of Baltimore aforesaid of the third or other part
